

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

1. Students are advised to visit the official Website of Foreign Students' Registry, University of Delhi: <http://fsr.du.ac.in/> or Website of University of Delhi: www.du.ac.in (> Students > Foreign Students) for detailed information about admission guidelines, general instructions, Deadlines and the **Online Application Form**.
2. All foreign nationals/ citizens applying for admission to University of Delhi, are required to apply through Foreign Students' Registry (FSR) office only. **This is applicable even if the concerned foreign student has given the qualifying examination from an Indian Board/ University.**
3. All students seeking admission to University of Delhi are strongly advised **not to use the services of third party/ agents/ admission service firms.**

University of Delhi has not authorized any agency/ individual/ agent to act on its behalf and/ or to charge any fee from prospective students.

Applications/ inquiries received through middlemen/ third party will not be entertained and will be categorically rejected.

4. All foreign nationals seeking admission are informed that they will have to get valid Student Visa/ Research visa, on getting provisional admission to the University.

No student will be registered/ admitted on Tourist Visa/ X-Visa.

5. All foreign nationals with medium of education other than English must submit **English Proficiency Certificate or TOEFL (minimum 70) or IELTS (minimum 6)** scores at the time of submission of application for admission in the University. If candidate is unable to provide any of these scores certificate or English proficiency certificate then the candidate will pursue English Language Proficiency course conducted by the Department of Adult and continuing Education, University of Delhi.
6. All foreign students who have done their school/ Degree education from foreign board/ University must provide the **equivalence of the degree/school certificate** from the Association of Indian University (AIU) before submission of his/her application. It is not applicable to those who have studied in India.
7. All foreign nationals are required to have **medical insurance with evacuation clause**, at time of admission and must renew it during the tenure of their studies in University of Delhi.
8. The student should **fill the Online Application Form**, as per instructions uploaded on the website and post the attested application form with documents to this office {Foreign Students' Registry (FSR), Room No. 11, First Floor, Conference Center, University of Delhi -110007} or submit the form through their Embassy in Delhi.
9. The students are advised to contact the Indian High Commission in their country for information regarding Scholarships (such as Indian Council for Cultural Relations).

11. All foreign students from Nepal must submit his/her passport copy along with application form and should also provide their Date of Birth certificate (DOB) in English transcript. Tibetan students have to provide RC issued by Government of India.

These deadlines may be brought to the notice of all foreign nationals seeking admission.

The deadlines will be strictly followed
