# Financial Directives on the Equalization of non-Jordanian Certificates and the Attestation of Academic Certificates and Documents Issued by Higher-Education Institutions Nr. (1) of 2010

Enacted pursuant to Paragraph (B), Article (12) of the Law of Higher Education and Scientific Research Nr. (23) of 2009 and its Amendments

#### Article (1)

These directives is cited as "Financial Directives as regards the Equalization of non-Jordanian Certificates and the Attestation of Academic Certificates and Documents Issued by Higher-Education Institutions" and become effective as of their date of publication in the Official Gazette.

#### Article (2)

The following words and expressions, wherever mentioned herein, have the hereinafter designated meanings, unless the context requires otherwise:

Ministry Minister	:	Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research

Secretary General	:	Secretary General of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research
Academic certificates and documents	:	Academic certificates and documents given by Jordanian and non- Jordanian higher-education institutions in which the study period is not less than one academic year after acquiring the Jordanian general high- school certificate or its equivalent.
Equalized document Commission		A document issued by the Ministry which includes the equalization of certificates issued by non-Jordanian higher-education institutions. Commission on the Recognition of non-Jordanian Higher-Education Institutions and the Equalization of their Certificates.

# Article (3)

- A. The Ministry will charge fees for examining applications for equalizing non-Jordanian certificates and for issuing the respective equalized documents according to the level of the academic certificate, as follows:
  - 1. Third university degree (Ph.D.) or its equivalent: Seventy Five Dinars (JD75).
  - 2. Higher diploma certificate and second university degree (MA) or their equivalents: Fifty Dinars (JD50).
  - 3. First university degree (B.A.) or its equivalent: Thirty Dinars (JD30).
  - 4. Intermediate university certificate or the 3-year intermediate diploma: Fifteen Dinars (JD15).
  - 5. Intermediate university certificate or the 2-year intermediate diploma: Ten Dinars (JD10).
  - 6. The one-year intermediate diploma: Five Dinars (JD5).
  - 7. Fifteen Dinars will be charged for the equalized document in English.

- 8. Two Dinars will be charged for any additional original copy of the equalized document.
- 9. Examining appeals against the Commission's decision: same fees mentioned above and according to the academic level of the certificate.
- 10. Issuing an equalized document (substitute for a lost document): same fees mentioned in clauses (1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6) above and according to the academic level of the certificate.
- B. Non-Jordanians will be charged three times the fees mentioned in Paragraph (A).
- C. The Ministry will charge higher-education institutions the following fees:
  - 1. Fee for holding training courses and for following up such courses: (Five Dinars for each trainee).
  - 2. Fee for issuing course passing certificates: (Fifteen Dinars for each trainee who has passed the course).
- D. The Ministry will charge Jordanians (JD10) and non-Jordanians (JD20) for examining and attesting experience certificates of the members of the teaching staff.

# Article (4)

The Ministry or any of its affiliated authorities (*cultural bureaus in the official Jordanian universities*) authorized to attest certificates, will charge a fee of (JD1) for attesting any original certificate/document or a copy thereof. Such fees will be collected by the stamping machines or by attaching the stamps of academic certificates attestation.

#### Article (5)

The "Financial Directives as regards the Equalization of non-Jordanian Certificates and the Attestation of Academic Certificates and Documents Issued by Higher-Education Institutions and its Amendments Nr. (1) of 2007" and all directives that contradict the provisions herein will be abolished.
